- 1. 6.1 Business Bulletin
 - a. Powderhall Railway Line "Positive" talks with Network Rail, aiming to get valuation for land so that CEC can purchase.
 - b. Travelling Safely Update
 - i. <u>City Centre ETRO</u> now out for consultation (closes 18th August)
 - ii. East ETRO now out for consultation (closes 24th October)
 - iii. North, South and West ETROs expected soon.
 - iv. ETROs for the four schemes being amended (Greenbank-Meadows, Silverknowes North, Silverknowes South and Comiston Road) are expected in Autumn.

Trams to Newhaven

Planters etc - these help to prevent pavement parking; need to be replaced with bollards or cycle racks

Given the tramway opened on 07.06.2023 now just under one year ago Spokes finds it very disappointing officer time and money is being spent on matters such as planters when the cycleway isn't officially open yet.

West Edinburgh Transport Improvements

Failure to accommodate active travel and unclear whether projects will be taken forward. Projects usually die when descoped (e.g. Rutland Square section of CCWEL).

Good to see additional road capacity of Maybury Junction being removed from the project.

7/7/7 Bus Lanes

Spokes supports expanding bus lane hours to provide enhanced bus priority and to protect cyclists from vehicles in bus lanes. However, we are disappointed by the exceptional length of time that this proposal has taken. An initial consultation was undertaken nearly five years ago whilst other cities such as London have gone much further, much quicker.

The cost of implementing expanded bus lane hours is relatively low and broadly relate to signage and refreshing markings. Given this, we would urge for a broader implementation to be prioritised as soon as possible.

Circulation Plan

Spokes are disappointed to see the delayed timescale for traffic reduction measures within the city centre. This is particularly given the very small timescale since the previous report was taken to committee.

The Cowgate has already been one-way for significant duration during the construction of the Virgin Hotel. This can presumably be replicated very quickly with operational issues already known.

7.6 Review of London Road junction and Picardy Place

Left turn technical risk for cyclists who wait at London Rd not at the cycle signal on Elm Row pedestrian crossing to Gayfield Square. Seems increasingly busy with the area at London Road full of southbound cycles waiting

8.1 Motion from Cllr McKenzie.

Spokes strongly supports this motion, particularly the need to connect the new infrastructure to the Canal towpath.



Has effect of induced demand been adequately considered? i.e. if the Bridges corridor was to be bus gated would the Picardy Place / Leith Street congestion issue be remedied? Has swept path analysis been done, including effect on cyclists using carriageway (rather than cycleway), if HGVs are turning left from the middle lane?
