- All Road Markings that are taken up during the works are to be replaced in accordance with 'The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016' and its subsequent amendments.
- High friction surfacing to CI 970AR, colour grey
 - Area of surfacing with red coloured chippings
- White road markings:**
- Stop Line, 200mm wide
 - Lane Lines, 4m mark, 2m gap, 100mm wide
 - Give Way, 600mm mark, 300mm gap, 100 wide
 - Give Way, 600mm mark, 300mm gap, 200mm wide
 - Cycle Lane Taper, 600mm line, 300mm gap, 100 wide
 - Road studs, 100mm square stainless steel, 500mm spacing
 - Diag 1057, 1.215m or 2.75m high
 - Triangle, 750mm wide, 1000mm high

- Diag 1017, 75mm wide
 - Diag 1018.1, 75mm wide

- New carriageway gully to Std Drg 5601/3 with 150mm tall connecting into existing gully tail. Gully frame to be narrow profile
 - Glasdon cyclenmaster bollard
